

Guidelines for Australian/PR students completing their Deakin College Diploma in June 2012 and transferring to Deakin University in July 2012

Applicants who will be completing an Deakin College in Trimester 1 – June 2012 and seeking a CSP at Deakin University in July 2012 will be required to complete a *University Direct Application form*.

PLEASE NOTE – ENTRY TO DEAKIN UNIVERSITY COURSES IN JULY IS NOT GUARANTEED AND IS SUBJECT TO COURSE AVAILABILITY.

The sequence of dates and steps is as follows:

Date	Step
Friday 1 June 2012	<p>You must hand in to Deakin College Reception:</p> <p>Completed <i>University Direct Application form</i> and attached supporting documentation (with the exception of final results).</p> <p>Late applications will not be accepted.</p> <p>Note: supporting documentation includes - certified copies of previous school results you used to obtain for exemptions at Deakin College; and a personal statement which can add value to your application.</p> <p>It is important to list 3 course preferences on the application form in case you do not achieve the marks for your desired campus.</p>
Tuesday 19 June 2012	<p>Deakin College will send your Deakin College official results directly to Deakin University.</p>
Monday, 25 June 2012	<p>Deakin University will send you an email outlining your application outcome.</p> <p>If you have not received an email by the 26 June 2012 please contact Deakin College immediately on tel: 9244 5600 or email: Carol.glover@deakin.edu.au</p>
Tuesday 3 July – Thursday 5 July 2012	<p>If you receive a Deakin University Offer you must attend enrolment day and collect your new Deakin University ID Card.</p>
