HOW TO PAY YOUR FEES

Payment can be made by:

- **BPAY – Deakin College’s Preferred Method of Payment**

Details are provided on the Deakin College Student Portal. You will need to generate a Provisional Invoice: go to *Student / Fees Calculator*. Please select your units for your enrolment and generate the invoice. The *BPAY Reference Number* stated on the invoice is a unique number, especially assigned to you and must be quoted as the Student BPAY Reference Number when making your BPAY payment. **Please do not use another person’s BPAY Reference Number.** The Deakin College Biller Code is 878843.

- **Credit Card**

Visa and MasterCard accepted only. A 1.5% surcharge applies. Credit card payments can be made at Deakin College Reception or via the Deakin College Student Portal.
