

## UNIQUE STUDENT IDENTIFIER

Any student who studied or completed a recognised Vocational Education and Training (VET) course must have a *Unique Student Identifier* ('USI'). This is a reference number made up of numbers and letters which will allow you to see all of your future results from any VET provider in Australia.

**Deakin College is not permitted to issue you a transcript or a testamur unless you have provided your USI.**

If you were enrolled in the *Certificate IV in Tertiary Preparation Program* and have not yet obtained your academic transcript or testamur, you must apply for a USI and provide this to Deakin College.
